The NSW Waste and Resource Recovery Strategy

Increase recycling rates by 2021

- Commercial and industrial waste to 70%
- Construction and demolition waste to 80%



NSW EPA Circular Economy

Keeping valuable resources out of landfill by funding industrial ecology projects.

What is industrial ecology?

"Industrial ecology is trying to mirror natural ecology and design industrial systems so that we design waste out of the process. That is the ultimate goal."

The Circulate Program

Development of industrial ecology relationships between NSW organisations to divert materials from landfill

- June 2014 to June 2015
- 6 projects, \$1,623,965

Diverted over 20,000t of materials from landfill

- August 2015 to June 2017
- 11 projects, \$1,336,307

 Diverted over 30,000t of materials from landfill




Case Study: Organics

- Contamination, specific foods only
- Concept proven, then replicated



NSW Government's C&D recycling target of 80% by 2021

 \$75,000 awarded to Cardno in partnership with Southern Materials Advisory in the Illawarra

 Trialled 2 methodologies to divert 6,000t mudstone and sandstone spoil from landfill



Circulate Round 3 – Overcoming barriers




